Yongseok Oh Square and Square

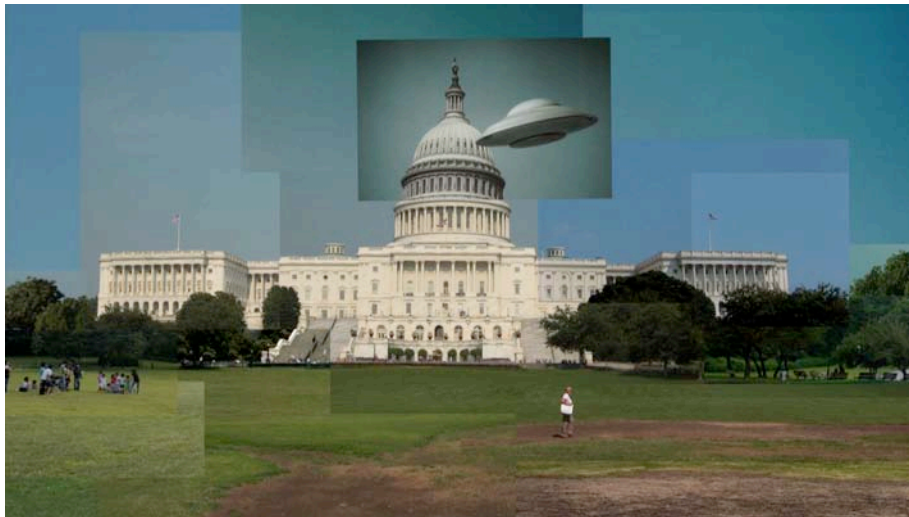


Image: Yongseok Oh, *Drama Variation (still)*, 2008, single channel video, duration: 4 min

After undertaking a 3 month **Asialink** residency at **Artspace**, Sydney, Korean artist in residence, **Yongseok Oh** will screen 5 video works in The Atrium at **Federation Square**, Melbourne.

The title of Yongseok’s project references the multiple viewpoints offered by the artist’s works and the physical reality of being screened at Federation Square. Film excerpts and stills are stitched together to reconstruct reality, and the works confuse the past and present by amalgamating real and imagined places.

Yongseok is participating in one of 3 reciprocal residencies facilitated by Asialink, a not for profit organisation with an annual residency program that sends 30+ Australian writers, arts managers, visual and performing artists to Asia. Since 2010 Asialink has facilitated this partnership between Changdong Art Studio, Korea and Artspace, Sydney.
